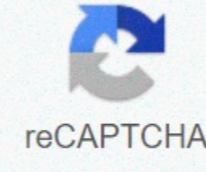

## Texas motor speedway camping map infield

Buy the Route More Info Texas Motor Speedway online map offers several areas where you will park your camper for the weekend. Burnout Alley is a premium area located above the rear seat with 30-by-60-foot sites and full hookups. Burnout Alley includes free Wi-Fi internet access, concierge service and 10 VIP passes for all races. Reserved camping on the ground is available in the center of the trail. Coach-Net Vip Camp is located near the stands and includes showers and toilets. These sites are self-secret just camping (no mergers) and sell out quickly every year. Located on the east side of Victory Circle Camp, the family campsite is designed for families, with a noise curfew and zero tolerance for disruptive behaviour. There are 1,700 camps available during major races on the west side of the carriageway. A line forms at the first gate north of Petty Place on the Victory Circle. Be sure to check the Texas Motor Speedway website during the staging and when the camp gates will open. Independent camps measure about 20 to 40 feet. Escape the hustle and bustle of the trail by camping at Vineyards Campground, located 11 miles from Texas Motor Speedway on Grapevine Lake. This RV park has full connections that include 20-, 30- and 50-amp electrical services and Wi-Fi internet access. Facilities include a laundromat, a fishing pier and a boat ramp. Between races, take a short walk or kayak on Grapevine Lake. Camping at an event like the NASCAR race at Texas Motor Speedway is an exciting way to enjoy a weekend and meet like-minded people. Plan ahead by preparing your camp for a self-contained campsite, as most camping is available on the parking-only trail, with no electrical or water connections. There are third-party suppliers that will pump gray and black water or fill your freshwater tanks for a fee. Make sure your propane tanks, generators and batteries are ready before you get there. If you need a break from the food on the trail and want to get out of the caravan, then head to the nearby town of Roanoke, just four miles from Motor road. Classic Cafe is a casual, reasonably priced restaurant, while Seasons Fresh Grill is a seasonally inspired restaurant that relies on fresh organic sources. Texas Motor Speedway offers a variety of options for staying outdoors and enjoying friends, family, entertainment and fans while camping on site. Mr. Camping TEXAS MOTOR SPEEDWAY CAMPING INFORMATION Taken from the Texas Motor Speedway Official Site If you plan to make Texas Motor Speedway your home away from home - literally - during the upcoming racing weekend, we want you to know that we will make your stay as hospitable and friendly as possible - an experience that you, your family and friends will want to repeat year after year! How are we going to do that? Just look at some of the special services campers enjoy during a racing weekend: a landfill on the property. Mobile trucks circling camping areas offer waste collection and water supply replenishment for a small fee. If your RV needs urgent repairs, we'll have a company available to help with nominal fees. If you need this service and don't see one of these repairers right away, every security officer will be happy to find it for you. Speedway offers five different campsites tailored to a wide range of needs and requirements. Camping is allowed only in certain areas. (Camping on the ground – VIP camping – Outdoors booked and unreserved camping) Call 817-317-5502 for any police, fire or ambulance needs that occur during your time at Texas Motor Speedway. This number is intended only for emergencies requiring assistance from the services listed above. For any problems with the out-of-emergency camp, please go to the public safety trailer located at Lone Star Circle Camp near row EE. No outdoor catering is allowed at the speedway. All hospitality industry must be coordinated through Levy Restaurants Sports & Entertainment (817) 215-8438. Access to the camps will be limited to vehicles with the appropriate event designation or sticker. Campers will only get two camping permits per place. All camping permits MUST be attached to each vehicle entering/exiting the camping area. THE STRIPED LABEL IS SPECIFIC TO YOUR RV. THE HARD STICKER IS FOR YOUR PERSONAL VEHICLE. CARS WITH STRIPED STICKERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE CAMPS. Unoccupied campsites cannot be tied to booking purposes. All spaces must be paid at the time of occupancy. No Non-Texas Motor Speedway Speedway will be allowed in any of the camps or speedway grounds. Open flames or open campfires are prohibited anywhere on speedway property. Charcoal and gas grills are allowed in camps, except in the field during race training or during the race. All grills must be at least 10 feet away from flammable appliances – cars, campers, tents, awnings, etc. A maximum of 10 gallons of gasoline allowed per camp. Petrol should never be used or stored in the immediate vicinity of heat or flame sources and must be stored in approved containers. All pets on the speedway property must be kept on a toad while outside their personal vehicle. ATVs or personal golf carts will not be allowed. Swimming pools or hot tubs are not allowed. No Stage, Stage Lights, Live Bands or Live DJ's Don't park your caravans in fire lanes or within 10 feet of hydrants. Hydrants must be accessible to emergency vehicles. Parking is not allowed in front of the pillars (signs will be placed). Tent-only camps are not allowed generators. All camping-related vehicles for tents only must be parked in designated parking lots. Two-wheeled motor vehicles (including licensed motorcycles) will not be allowed in camps, including terrain. All camps will be patrolled aggressively by Speedway security personnel and city police officers; implementing a zero tolerance policy on all camp policies. Trailers with a flat bed (more than 10 feet in length) will not be allowed in the camps. In the camps will not be allowed trucks with boxes, absolutely without the allowed cruise in any of the camps. No lewd behavior will be allowed on the speedway property. A 1-hour. m will be enforced in all camps. (Does not include generators) All infield camping areas must comply with 13' height regulation - meaning anything above 13' must be removed. WARNING: Carbon monoxide poisoning is possible with camping equipment. Follow the instructions on the equipment! REMINDER: Anyone operating unlicensed motor vehicles (ATV, golf cart, two-wheeled vehicles, etc.), will be asked to take them off the property immediately and not return. Please understand that these rules come with your safety in mind as a valued customer of Texas Motor Speedway. Please call the Texas Motor Speedway Ticket Office at (817) 215-8500 for more information or book a camping area. Get in the middle of the action by camping in a field reserved area during race weekend! The extensive camp on the ground offers several types of reserved spaces – Wall, Interior and Paved Paddock. Reserved Infield RV spaces are about 20' x 40'. All infield camping also requires every person to have an Infield Pass, which can be purchased at the door. The camper dump is located next to the north tunnel near Allison Avenue, and two shower/restroom properties are located at both ends of Allison Avenue next to the garage areas. Infield, Infield are sold until the season and are sold out. Starting in 2008, The New York Times Weekend Infield Passes — \$70 if purchased before Race Week! The reserved VIP camping area of Blue Ox is located between Allison Avenue and Labonte Lane at the southern end of the track. VIP Camping placeholders have a number of special amenities, including a large 20 x 45' tiled area, 24-hour security, a main location near the main grandstand, proximity to toilets and showers, and electrical and water couplings.
